

RiskyProject Tip of the Month

As part of your risk planning, you can create mitigation (qualitative) or response (quantitative) plans in the Risk Mitigation/Response view. Once you have created these plans you can assign them to one or more risks in the Risk Waterfall chart.

- **Mitigation plans:** you define a name, cost, changes in probability and /or impact as well as provide a detailed description of the actions must be performed as part of the plan. These plans can then be assigned to risks in the Waterfall Chart.
- **Response plans:** you define a name, Outcome Type (cost, schedule), Outcome, and Chance (probability) and Cost. You then assign the response plan to risks in one of the risk assignment views. During Monte Carlo simulations, the impact of the response plan to a risk occurring becomes part of the quantitative analysis.
